



The Young house was a Folk Victorian house built in 1885. The Youngs, standing in front from left to right, are Albert, Robert (in buggy), Alice, and Mary. The house was called a "gem of architectural beauty" in the 1882 *History of Contra Costa County*. In 1983, it was restored and used as the model for an adjacent office complex at 911 San Ramon Valley Boulevard in Danville.
